

James Willis Mumper, (24 Feb 1890 – 10 Oct 1956), Duncannon Record, October 12, 1956

James Willis Mumper, 66, of 2308 Harvard Ave., Camp Hill, died suddenly of a heart attack Wednesday noon while walking along N. 2nd St., near Pine Street in Harrisburg.

Mr. Mumper was a son of **James C.** and **Martha A. Mumper**. He was a former resident of Duncannon Pennsylvania, and was employed at the state auditor general's department and was a member of the Camp Hill, Presbyterian church.
