

Charles L. Murdock, (Died 24 Jan 1943), The Duncannon Record, Thursday, January 24, 1943

Charles L. Murdock, 62, died instantly of a paralytic stroke at the home of his sister, **Mrs. C. M. Meadeth**, of Cisna Run, on Thursday morning, with whom he had his home the past ten years. He was a son of **John** and **Ella Kennedy Murdock** and was born in Cumberland County. He had suffered two strokes previously which had left one arm helpless. **Mr. Murdoch** was a member of the Brethren Church, of Waynesboro, and of the Mechanic Fire and Hose Company, No. 1, of Waynesboro.

Surviving him are his wife, of Waynesboro; the following sons and daughters: **Edith, Mrs. Fred Morrow**, of Mercersburg, Pa.; **Anna, Mrs. Elmer Sites**, of Blue Ridge Summit; **Mary Jane, Mrs. Harvey Morrow**, of Mercersburg; **Corporal Thomas Murdock**, of Garner Field, Calif.; **John, Charles** and **Geither Murdock**, all of Waynesboro; four grandchildren, two brothers and two sisters, **Mrs. Anna Wingert**, of Winber, Pa.; **William** and **Ray Murdock**, of Harrisburg, and **Edith, Mrs. C. M. Meredith**, of Cisna Run.

Funeral services were held on Sunday at 2 p.m. at the White Church, above Shippensburg, Rev. Diffenderfer, of the Brethren Church, Waynesboro, officiating, and burial was made in the White Church Cemetery. Members of the fire company served as pallbearers.
