

Ross Mutzabaugh, (Died 12 Nov 1917), Philadelphia Inquirer, Tuesday, November 13, 1917
Auto Kills Four-Year Old - - - Child Runs Into Street Directly in Front of Machine,

Special to the Inquirer. Marysville, Pa., Nov 12. – Four year-old **Ross Mutzabaugh**, son of **Benjamin Mutzabaugh**, was run down and almost instantly killed on North High Street, Duncannon, today, by an automobile containing two Philadelphians, **Edward Mertz**, and **George R. Henninger**. Mertz was driving the car.

Mrs. Myrtle Raisner was the only person in addition to the autoists who witnessed the accident. She asserted that the lad had just declared he was going to search for his brother when he stepped from the pavement directly into the path of the approaching car, was knocked down and run over by it.

The tragedy was purely accidental. As soon as the car had hit the boy it stopped, and **Henninger** carried the lad into the home of his grandmother, but he died within a few minutes.
