

Mary E. (Zorger) Myers, (8 May 1850 – 14 Apr 1920), Patriot, Monday, April 19, 1920, Aged resident of Marysville Dies

After suffering three years with dropsy, **Mary E.**, wife of **William A. Myers**, died early Wednesday morning. She was the daughter of **Mr.** and **Mrs. John Zorger** and was born at the old homestead at Pine Hill, Carroll Township, May 8, 1850.

She is survived by her husband and the following sons and daughters: **J. A. Myers; W. A. Myers, Jr.; Mrs. Fred McNeeley Mrs. George Harrold; Mrs. Grafton Rhoads; Mrs. Howard Keim; Miss Mayme Myers** and **Miss Mona Myers**, all of this place. She is also survived by one brother, **Jacob Zorger**, of Pine Hill and one sister, **Mrs. Sue Sweger**, of Pittsburgh.

For many years she resided in Rye Township, near Glenvale; a few years ago moving to her late residence in Valley Street. She was a member of the Church of God. Funeral services conducted by the Rev. George Albright, of York, were held at the house, Saturday afternoon at 3 o'clock, after which burial was made in Chestnut Grove Cemetery.
