

Ida Elizabeth (Shatto) Nason, (1862 - 9 Nov 1899), Toledo Daily, November 9, 1899, Sudden Death of **Mrs. Nason** - Taken with Convulsions Last Night -- East Side Locals

Mrs. William Nason died very suddenly this morning at 2 o'clock at her home at No. 1232 Oak street. She was in her usual health yesterday, and about midnight, was taken with convulsions from which she never rallied. Dr. Hathaway was called, but all remedies failed. **Mr. Nason** is employed at No. 10 engine-house. He was summoned and was with her up to the time of her death. Besides the husband three children survive. **Mrs. Nason** was about 37 years of age, and during her residence on the East Side, had gained many friends whose sympathies will be extended to the bereaved family. Arrangements have not yet been made for the funeral, but it will probably be held on Saturday.
