

Harold C. Neal, (Died 25 Mar 1918), Patriot, Tuesday, March 26, 1918; **Harold Neal Dies Suddenly – Succumbs to Attack of Uremic Poisoning at His Cove Allen Country Place – Prominent Agriculturist**

Harold Neal, aged 28 years a prominent agriculturist and poultry fancier, died yesterday afternoon at 5:00 o'clock from an acute attack of uremic poisoning at his home, the Kinkora, at Cove Allen.

Death was very sudden as he had only been ill for seven hours.

Mr. Neal was single and resided at the Kinkora with a Filipino servant. **Mr. Neal** was the son of the late **R. C. Neal, Sr.**, and worked in his father's rolling mills, the old Lochiel plant. Four years ago he moved to the farm at Cove Allen. The farm covers more than 1000 acres.

Mr. Neal was a graduate of Yale College. Immediately after graduation he entered the employ of his father at the rolling mills. He is survived by a brother, **Robert C. Neal Jr.** of this city, who left last evening for Cove Allen. No funeral arrangements have been made.
