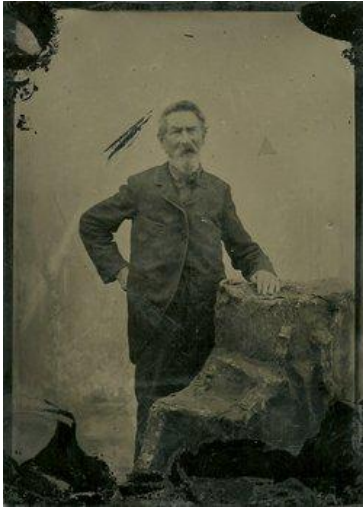


James Arthur Nesbit, (21 Feb 1833 – 15 Jan 1903), Patriot, January 20, 1903



James Nesbit, aged 69, one of the oldest citizens of Marysville died at his home on North Main Street last Thursday. While living here until the last few years, he worked for the Northern Central Railroad a period of about 40 years. He was a veteran of the Civil War, having been in the battle of Gettysburg and the pursuit of the enemy after the battle. He was a member of the 158th Regiment, Pennsylvania Volunteers, and was honorably discharged at Chambersburg, August 12, 1863. He was also in the first attack upon Richmond and the capture of Fortress Monroe. He was a member of Perry Lodge No 458 Free and Accepted Masons.GAR, enlisted in Union Army on November 1, 1862 and joined Co A 158th Infantry Regiment Pennsylvania. Mustered out on August 12, 1863, Chambersburg Pa.
