

Mrs. Fannie B. (Hamilton) Noss, (Died 29 May 1935), Duncannon Record, Thursday, June 6, 1935

Funeral services for **Mrs. Fannie B. Noss**, who died at her home in Harrisburg Wednesday afternoon of last week, were held at her late home Sunday afternoon, Rev. David E. Young, pastor the Sixth Street United Brethren Church, officiated the remains brought to this place and interred in the Duncannon Cemetery.

Deceased who was aged 68 years, was a native of this place and will be remembered as **Miss Fannie Hamilton**, following her marriage to **Mr. George Noss**, they continued to reside here, later removing to Harrisburg, where she continued to reside until the time of her death. In addition to her husband she is survived by two daughters, **Miss Helen Noss** and **Miss Elisabeth Noss**, at home; two sons, **Harry Noss** and **Charles Noss** of Harrisburg. A brother, **Robert Hamilton**, of this place, also survives.
