

Isaac Louden Noye (17 Nov 1825 – 25 Feb 1901), Newport News, March 7, 1901

Isaac Noye, who died of pneumonia the 25th ult. at the home of his son, **Theodore Noye**, in Howe Township after an illness of sever weeks, was born in Cumberland County, Pa. November 17, 1825, and had resided in Perry County since 1835. He was blind for the past six years. He was a member of Company E. 19th Pennsylvania Volunteers during the Civil War. Four sons and two daughters survive him, namely; **Mrs. John L. Shatto**, of Shermansdale; **Miss Lissie**, of Lancaster; **Theodore**, of Howe Township; **John** and **Charles** of Harrisburg; and **Andrew**, of West Fairview. Funeral services were conducted last Thursday by Rev. E.G. Baker, pastor; Interment at Shermansdale, his four sons were the pallbearers.
