Roszeal A. (Frymire) Palmer, 86, of Marysville died Tuesday, Sept. 22, 2009 at Harrisburg Hospital.

She was born April 24, 1923 to the late **Pearl Frymire**, and was a lifelong resident of Marysville.

She retired as office manager for Bock Paper Company, Wormleysburg, a company owned and operated by Palmer and her husband, and previously worked as a seamstress at Marysville Dress Company; and a former member of Marysville Methodist Church and a member of Bethany United Methodist Church, where she sang in choirs for 50 years and was a member of United Methodist Women and the Chapel Sunday School Class.

She was a former Girl Scout and Cub Scout leader; past president of the West Shore Soroptimist Club; charter president of the Marysville Lioness Club; and active with Marysville Golden Age, Perry County Council of Republican Women and Meals on Wheels.

She worked with her husband at the Marysville Lions Club Carnival, where she locally was known as the "cake lady," calling people in Marysville for donations for the cake stand.

Surviving are her husband of 66 years, **Donald G. Palmer Sr.**; a daughter, **Susan Palmer Kline** of Lemoyne; two sons, **Donald G. Jr.** of Lancaster and **David G.** of Marysville; three grandsons, **Steven, Chad** and **Bret Palmer**; three granddaughters, **Alexis Palmer, Courtney Kline** and **Dionna Palmer**; and two great-grandsons.

Services were held Sept. 28 in her church with the Rev. Carola Beasley-Topliffe officiating.

Burial was in Perry Heights Cemetery, Marysville.
