

Frank Fulton Patterson, (Died 3 Nov 1918), Patriot, Wednesday, November 6, 1918

Frank Fulton Patterson, of New York City, died in that city Sunday evening at 10 o'clock after a short illness. He was a former Harrisburg resident and was well known here.

Since leaving Harrisburg he has been in the employ of the Government as a machinist at Washington and Rock Island, Ill. Of late years while in the Pullman service, he has resided in New York.

He is survived by his **wife** and one **son**, also his parents, **Mr. and Mrs. H. R. Patterson**, 208 South Thirteenth Street; three sisters, Miss **Anna Patterson**, a teacher in this city; **Mrs. George Bell**, Detroit, and Miss **Jane Patterson**. An only brother, Ensign **Kenneth Patterson**, is overseas. Burial will be made at Newport, Thursday. Services will be conducted by Dr. George Edward Hawes, pastor of Market Square Presbyterian Church.
