Roy J. "Pete" Peterman Jr., 66, of Zanesville, Ohio, died Tuesday, Sept. 1, 2009 at Ohio State University Hospital.

He was born Thursday, July 29, 1943 in New Bloomfield to **Roy J. Peterman Sr.** and the late **Ida Elizabeth (Cassett) Peterman**.

He retired in 1998 from Ohio Bell Telephone Company as a computer technician after 25 years service, and was a mathematics teacher at Zane State College; a Navy veteran of the Vietnam War and a retired commander, receiving the Distinguished Flying Cross and many other commendations; a member of St. Thomas Aquinas Catholic Church, where he served as an usher, Knights of Columbus Council 505, Zanesville Singers, VFW Post 1028 and the Association of Naval Aviation.
