

Mrs. Emma (Manmiller) Pressley, (Died 1 Jan 1904), Patriot, Monday, January 4, 1904

After an illness of two months, **Mrs. Emma Pressley**, aged 60 years, wife of **W. H. Pressley**, an engineer of the Pennsylvania Railroad, died on Thursday at her home, 1711 North Seventh Street.

She was born in Duncannon, but had been a resident of this city for thirty-five years. She was a member of the fifth Street M. E. Church and a member of the Ladies Auxiliary of the Brotherhood of Locomotive Engineers.

Besides her husband she is survived by four sons, John P., 1927 North Seventh Street; **William M.**, 2020 Moltke Avenue; **George W.**, 1707 North Seventh Street, and **Chester H.**, at home; one daughter, **Mrs. Robert Stair**, 320 Court Avenue, and two brothers, **William H.** and **George W. Manmiller**, both of Peru, Indiana.

Funeral services will be held at 2 o'clock on Monday afternoon, Rev. B. H. Hart, pastor of the Fifth Street M. E. Church, officiating and F. H. Gregory, Secretary of the Pennsylvania Railroad Young Men's Christian Association, assisting. Interment will be made in East Harrisburg Cemetery.
