

James Albert Reeder, (7 May 1895 – 17 May 1946), Vindicator and Republican, Estherville, IA, May 23, 1946; James Reeder, 51, Dies from Heart Trouble

James A. Reeder, 51, died at 6 o'clock Fri. night at Holy Family hospital after an illness of 11 days. He had been in poor health last winter and cause of his death was reported as heart trouble.

He was born May 7, 1895, in Newport, Pa. In 1926 he came to Estherville and on Oct. 26 of that year married **Lily Spratt** in Estherville. He served for eight months in the army during World War I. Because of poor health he was not able to work after coming to Estherville.

Survivors include his wife, two brothers, **Clarence** of Estherville and **Anderson** of New Bloomfield, Pa., and five sisters, **Belle Reeder** and **Mrs. Frank Reapsome** of Wila, Pa.; **Mrs. George Radle**, New Bloomfield, Pa.; **Mrs. Elma Beard**, Carlisle, Pa., and **Mrs. Albert Carver**, Stephenson, Va.

Funeral services were held at 2 o'clock Sunday afternoon at Sternborg's funeral chapel. Rev. John Cross officiated and burial was in Oakhill Cemetery.
