

Henry Rhinesmith (28 Dec 1819 – Nov 1897), Newport News, November 25, 1897

Harry Rhinesmith died in Landisburg at 1 o'clock Monday morning of infirmities due to advancing years. He was a well known citizen of this county, having been prominent as a Democrat for many years. He was elected director of the poor in 1857 and associated judge in 1889. Perry County was formed from Cumberland County. He was a member of the Reformed Church. His wife, **Frances**, to whom he was married March 23, 1843, and the following children survive him; **Mrs. George Patterson**, of Landisburg; **William** and **James**, of Spring Township; **Mrs. (Alice) Thomas Graham**, of Tyrone Township; and **Mrs. Charles H. Eaton**, of Landisburg. The funeral will be at his late residence in Landisburg this morning at 11 o'clock. Interment was in St. Peter's cemetery, Spring Township, Perry County.
