

Dorothy C. (Crozier) Rice, (21 Jun 1924 – 26 Feb 2010), Perry County Times, Wednesday, March 10, 2010

Dorothy C. Rice, 85, formerly of Carlisle and a resident of Messiah Village, Mechanicsburg, died Friday, Feb. 26, 2010.

She was born June 21, 1924 in Landisburg to the late **Charles W.** and **Annie Dunkleberger Crozier**.

She was a graduate of Landisburg High School and Carlisle Commercial College.

She married **John B. Rice**, formerly of Loysville, on Nov. 7, 1947. They farmed together outside of Loysville from 1948 to 1959 and then moved to Carlisle. He died Nov. 6, 2005.

She was employed by Dickinson School of Law in the admissions office from 1962 until her retirement in 1989; a member of Wesleyan Church of the Cross, Carlisle, and North Middleton Senior Citizens; and enjoyed gardening.
