

Kate (Moyer) Rice, (1852 – 6 Feb 1889), Newspaper Clipping, The Perry Historians; Death of **Mrs. J.W. Rice**.

Last week we announced the critical illness of **Mrs. J.W. Rice**, of this borough. On Wednesday morning, between 9 and 10 o'clock, her spirit took its flight. Peritonitis set in after the birth of her baby, two week previous to her demise, followed by pneumonia, which was the immediate cause of her death. As a school teacher **Miss Kate Moyer** was well and favorably known. She was married to **Mr. Rice** last winter and shortly after came here to reside. She was a good woman and all who knew her were deeply grieved to her of her death. Her remains were interred in the Bloomfield Cemetery on last Saturday. She was in her 37th year of her age.
