

Martin Luther Righter, (1861 – 29 Sep 1914), Patriot, September 30, 1914; Martin L. Righter, Of Duncannon, Dies

Duncannon, Sept. 29. – **Martin L. Righter**, died at his home on South Market Street, at 7 o'clock this morning aged 53 years, after a lingering sickness with tuberculosis. He is survived by his widow and two daughter, **Mrs. E. Chilis Smith** of this place and **Mrs. Hugh Leak** of North Carolina, several brothers and one sister. The deceased for a number of years was employed by the Duncannon Iron Company, but of late years he had conducted a successful barber trade, which trade he retired from several months ago owing to failing health. He was a member of several local fraternal organizations. Funeral service has not yet been made.
