

**Sarah Ann (Baker) Ritter**, (17 Oct 1840 – 11 Dec 1912), Perry County Democrat, December 15, 1912;

Loysville, Pa. December 16, 1912, **Sarah Anna Ritter** died of Bright's disease at the residence of her daughter, **Mrs. George Arnold**, last Wednesday evening, December 11th. She was the daughter of **Fredrick Baker** and **wife** and was born, October 17, 1840. She was married to **John H. Ritter** November 27, 1866. To this union three children were born, two daughters and one son: **Rebecca**, (**Mrs. George Arnold**); **Mary** (**Mrs. George Ickes**); both of this place, and John, of Minnesota. Three sisters and two brothers also survive her.

She was one of a family of thirteen children, twelve of them growing to manhood and womanhood. A number of years ago she was afflicted with a severe spell of typhoid fever. Since then her health had not been as robust as before and it also slightly affected her mind. **Mr. Ritter** preceded her to the eternal world some years ago.

She was a member of the Reformed Church and was a quiet unassuming woman, and a good and kind wife and mother. Funeral services were held at the residence of her daughter, **Mrs. George Ickes**, on Saturday, Rev. Royer officiating; interment in the cemetery. She was aged 72 years, 1 month, and 24 days.
