

Earl Seiger Roth, (24 Oct 1926 – 26 Jan 1943), Duncannon Record, Thursday, February 4, 1943; Dies After Boxing Match

Earl Seiger Roth, 16, son of **Mr.** and **Mrs. Earl W. Roth**, of South Main Street, succumbed to death on Tuesday, January 26th, at his home. He had become ill over the week end and his condition became suddenly worse Tuesday morning.

Friends of the youth said they understood **Earl** had taken part in a friendly boxing bout on Sunday. He was employed at the New Cumberland Air Depot.

Meanwhile, **Roth's** younger brother, **Garry Lee**, 6, is a patient at the Harrisburg Hospital in a satisfactory condition, with severe burns of the legs and hips suffered recently. It was said the youngster's clothes caught fire while he was playing around a bonfire near his home.

Besides his parents, the brother and his grandfather, **Earl** is survived by three sisters, **Tierna**, **Patricia**, and **Demise Roth**, at home, and his maternal grandmother, **Mrs. Kathryn Seiger**, of Progress.

Funeral services were held on afternoon at the Deckard Funeral home with the Rev. G. Harper, pastor of the Marysville Church of God, officiating.
