

**Edwin K. Rudy**, (Died Dec 1935), Duncannon Record, Thursday, December 5, 1935

**E. K. Rudy**, aged 53 years, of Harrisburg died in a hospital in that city following a brief illness.

Deceased was employed as a railway mail clerk and had been ill but a short time prior to his death. He was a member of the Church of God.

In addition to his widow, he is survived by two daughters, **Mrs. H. L. Goodman**, Roselle Park, N.J., and **Mrs. J. C. Palmer**, of Harrisburg, and a son **E. K. Rudy, Jr.**, of York. Eleven grandchildren also survive. Before removing to Harrisburg the **Rudy's** resided at Kinkora Heights.

Brief funeral services were held at his late home Monday morning at 10 o'clock, Rev. Robert Martin, pastor of the Church of Christ, officiated and the remains taken to Union Deposit for interment.
