George W. Sanderson, son of **John** and **Sarah (Rice) Sanderson**, was born at Ickesburg, October 31, 1844. He attended the public schools and the New Bloomfield Academy, during the principalship of Prof. James A. Stephens, teaching three terms in the country schools, and two in the Loysville Orphans' School. In the meantime Prof. Stephens had taken charge of the Huntingdon Academy, and **Mr. Sanderson** attended it two terms. He then taught nine years in the Huntingdon schools and was principal at McConnellstown and Petersburg, after which he engaged in business at Huntingdon for thirty-nine years.
