

Honorable **Theodore C. Sanderson**, (Died 9 Feb 1902), Patriot, Monday, February 10, 1902.
T. C. Sanderson Dead – Member of Legislature from Bedford County and Prominent in Masonic Circles.

The death of **Hon. Theodore C. Sanderson** occurred on Saturday morning at his home, 617 Camp Street, after a lengthy sickness. Although a resident of this city for only a few months, he was well known in the business circles.

Mr. Sanderson was in his fifty-second year and was a representative in the recent legislature, from Bedford County, residing at the time of his election and for some time prior at Saxton. He was identified with several important measures in the assembly and was highly respected by the members of that body.

For twenty-eight years **Mr. Sanderson** was connected with the Huntingdon commandery of the Knights Templar and was prominent in other Masonic circles, being also affiliated with the Odds Fellows.

He was a native of Ickesburg, Perry County, but left there early in life. He removed to this city at the conclusion of the session of the legislature last spring and was a member of the firm of Fickes and Sanderson. He was in ill health since his removal to Harrisburg and his death was not expected.

Mr. Sanderson is survived by eight children as follows: **Harry**, a physician, of Johnstown; **Frank, Charles, Eugene, Clyde, Carrie** and **Roy**. Deceased was a member of the Lutheran church for many years and during his residence here was connected with the Augsburg Lutheran congregation. He was of an excellent Christian character and was prominent in church work at his former home in Bedford County.

The funeral will be held this afternoon with services at his late home. The funeral will be Masonic and a delegation from Huntingdon will attend and have charge. Rev. J. S. English, the former pastor of the deceased, will conduct assisted by Rev. Luther DeYoe, pastor of Messiah Lutheran Church. The interment will be made in the East Harrisburg Cemetery.

The following committee to represent the House of Representatives at the funeral tomorrow of the late Representative **Theodore C.
