**Anna Mary Scholl**, 94, of Duncannon, formerly of Marysville, died Wednesday, Feb. 9, 2011.

She was born March 22, 1916 in York to **Francis** and **Catherine (Waters) Whare**.

She was one of the last founding members of Our Lady of Good Counsel Catholic Church, Marysville, where she was a four-time president of the PCCW and was active until the last year of her life, and a member of the auxiliary of Knights of Columbus, Legion of Mary Prayers, York.
