**T. J. Scholl**, son of **Alfred C.** and **Sarah A. (Rice) Scholl**, was born in Landisburg, October 22, 1871. He attended the public schools, after which he took a course in Eastman Business College at Poughkeepsie, N. Y. He taught school three terms in Perry County, and in 1895 entered the First National Bank at Patton, Pennsylvania, as stenographer, later being elected cashier, a position which he filled for several years. He resigned to take up general auditing and examination work among banks and trust companies, subsequently entering the employ of the Second National Bank at Mechanicsburg. In 1913 he was promoted to cashier. **Mr. Scholl** is a member of the board of trustees of the Methodist Home for Children, near Mechanicsburg, as well as treasurer of the board of managers.
