

Lemuel H. Sellers, (Died 22 Mar 1914), Patriot, Monday, March 23, 1914, Marysville Man Dies From Paralysis

Marysville, March 22. – **Lemuel H. Sellers** died at his home on South Main Street this morning, aged 68 years, from the results of a paralytic stroke. He had been in poor health for a year. He was a veteran of the Civil War. He is survived by four sons, **Elmer** and **Harvey**, of this place; **Harry**, of Steelton, and **Charles**, of Middletown; five daughters, **Mrs. Edward Brown**, of Philadelphia; **Mrs. Charles Williamson**, of Yonkers, N.Y.; **Mrs. J. C. Beard**, of Marysville, and **Mabel** and **Nellie**, at home. He is also survived by three brothers and three sisters. The funeral will be held Tuesday afternoon at two o'clock with interment in the Chestnut Grove Cemetery.
