

Sarah (Lightbody) Shade, (29 Jun 1842 – 31 Jul 1915); The Late **Mrs. D. Shade**

Sadie Lightbody was born in Plainfield, Ohio, June 29, 1842, and died at her home one and three-quarter miles south of Daykin, Nebra., July 31, 1915, aged 73 years, 1 month, and 2 days.

She was united in marriage to **Daniel Shade** in Peoria County, Ill. on December 22, 1867. A few years later they moved to Iowa, and in 1870 came to Nebraska and lived here ever since. She was one of the pioneers of the state and helped to make this country what it is today. **Mrs. Shade** has been a member of the Methodist Church for many years. She served as a steward in the church and was instrumental in the building of the present parsonage.

Besides her husband, she leaves to mourn her one sister, **Mrs. G. F. Wilson**, of Savannah, Mo., one brother **J. J. Lightbody** of Geneva, and a half sister, **Mrs. Anna Jane Magness** of Plainfield Ohio, and many other relatives, friends, and neighbors.

The funeral was conducted at her home by Rev. E.G. Hibbens of Daykin, and interment in the cemetery of Geneva, Rev. W. L. Austin being in charge of the services at the grave.
