

Ambrose Shatto, (16 Feb 1850 – 20 May 1909), Denbigh Promoter, (North Dakota). May 28, 1909



Ambrose Shatto was born in Adams County, Pennsylvania, February 16th, 1850, and died May 20, 1909, aged 59 years, 3 months and 4 days. His death was caused by complications of diseases from which he suffered very intensely at times. He was hopeful of recovery until near the close of life when he expressed a desire to die and be at rest. The early part of his life was spent in Pennsylvania. At the age of fifteen he moved with his parents to Daviess County, Mo., where he resided until the spring of 1879, he moved with his family to Dickinson County, Kansas. He was married to **Ala C. Patton** March 13, 1875, but was only permitted to live with her for one short year when she was called away by death. To this union was born one son, who died in infancy. On November 1, 1877, he was again united in marriage to **Melvina Shaw**. To this union were born five children, four are now living, one daughter (Maude) passing away a little over a year ago. On February 16, 1893, death again called his companion. On March 25, 1895, he was again married to **Mrs. Ella Reish** of Quinter, Kansas. To this union was born three sons and four daughters only three are now living. Two sons and two daughters having passed away in infancy. In April, 1902, he moved with his family to Denbigh, N.D., where he has resided until the time of his death. He leaves a wife, four sons, three daughters, two step sons, one brother, three sisters and six grand children to mourn their loss.
