Rev. W. J. Sheaffer was born in Sheaffer's Valley, near Landisburg, July 18, 1863, the son of **John Baer** and **Emma Carrie (Spence) Sheaffer**. He attended the public schools and graduated from Williamsport Dickinson Seminary in 1890, with the A.B. degree. He graduated from Illinois Wesleyan University and from Oskalooska College, postgraduate work, with A.M. and Ph.D. degree in 1914. He entered the ministry of the Methodist Episcopal Church in 1890. He is now pastor at Jersey Shore, Pa., and secretary of the directors of the Methodist Home for Aged at Tyrone, Pa.
