**Dr. J. D. Shull** was born at Markelville, Perry County, June 10, 1851, the son of **Simon** and **Elizabeth (Fleisher) Shull**. He attended the common schools, Markelville Academy (1871-72), Juniata Valley Normal School (1874), Medical College of Physicians and Surgeons at Baltimore (1881-82), and graduated from the University of Pennsylvania in 1887. He practiced medicine at Markelville for about ten years, since which time he has been medical examiner of the Pennsylvania Railroad at Baltimore, a period of over thirty-three years.
