Timothy Baxter Shuman was a son of **Samuel** and **Susannah (Bixler) Shuman**, born August 1, 1857, at Eshcol, the father being noted as the champion wrestler of Perry County, an athletic sport of much note in that period. He was educated in the local schools. When entering young manhood he went with his parents to Huntingdon County, where he taught school, later entering the business world. He was appointed Register and Recorder of Mifflin County, by Governor Pattison.
