George P. Simon, 93, a resident of Chapel Pointe of Carlisle and a former resident of Perry County for 35 years, died Monday, Oct. 24, 2011 in Carlisle Regional Medical Center.

He was born April 14, 1919 in Mt. Jewitt, McKean County, to **George P.** and **Bertha Rathburn Simon**.

He retired from the Mechanicsburg Naval Ship Parts Control Center; was a Marine Corps veteran of World War II; a life member of Edson's Raiders Association, New Bloomfield VFW Post 7463 and Newport American Legion Post 177; and enjoyed cars, especially the Pontiac and took pride in caring for his own cars, and was a dog lover, especially golden retrievers.
