Richard Henry Stewart was born in Duncannon, May 23, 1859, his parents being **William Jones Stewart** and **Hannah (Henry) Stewart**. He was educated at the public schools and at the New Bloomfield Academy, and read law with the late **Charles A. Barnett**. He was admitted to the bar, December, 1881, and served as district attorney from 1885 to 1888. At the conclusion of his term he located at Kansas City, Missouri, where he practiced law and acted as trust officer of a large trust company. In 1901 he located in New York City, where he is engaged in corporation law practice. **Mr. Stewart** bears the unique distinction of being the father of one of America's leading theatrical stars, "**Marie Doro**," whose biography appears earlier in this book in an extended form.
