Dr. H. A. Stine was born April 23, 1878, at Pillow, Dauphin County, but was brought to Perry by his parents' removal here, when he was a mere child, so is recognized as a Perry Countian. He is a son of **Charles** and **Catherine (Row) Stine**. He was educated in the Perry County schools and graduated at the Cumberland Valley State Normal School in 1902. He taught for a number of years, and then entered Baltimore Medical College, where he graduated in 1912. He located at Harrisburg, where he has since practiced.
