Jess H. Sunday is one of the leading druggists of his section of Dauphin County, being the proprietor of the outstanding drug store in Millersburg, as well as serving his community and county as a member of organizations working for the prosperity and welfare of Millersburg and Dauphin.

Jess H. Sunday was born at Newport, Pennsylvania in 1895 a son of **Willis** and **Elizabeth (Hartzell) Sunday**. **Willis Sunday** established himself in the life of Newport as a butcher, a calling which he followed for many years, being active until the time of his death.

After obtaining his elementary and his secondary education in the public schools of Newport, Pennsylvania, **Jess H. Sunday** selected pharmacy for his career and entering the Philadelphia College of Pharmacy obtained his degree from that institution and in 1920, he established at Millersburg the leading drug merchandising establishment, which he has developed through the years until it occupies a unique position in the life of the community.

Mr. Sunday devotes his entire time to the management of his drug store, which he operates under the name of the Sunday Rexall Drug Store. Supporting his profession by membership in the Pennsylvania Pharmaceutical Association, **Mr. Sunday**, who despite his deep and abiding interest in political problems and civic affairs has never offered himself for public office, is a member of the Newport Lodge, Ancient Free and Accepted Masons, the local lodge of the Order of Redman and the Loyal Order of Moose and also belongs to the American Legion Social Club and Saint Paul's Lutheran Church.

Jess H. Sunday married at Newport, Pennsylvania, in 1919, **Clara Hostetter**. **Mr.** and **Mrs. Sunday** have become the parents of a son, **Rex**, who was born in 1921 and is now a student at Susquehanna University.
