Robert M. Thompson, deceased, was born in Delaware Township, February 14, 1822, son of **John** and **Jane Thompson**, of Thompsontown, Juniata County. **Robert Thompson** was engaged in farming in Delaware Township, where he died December 24, 1879. He married his first wife, **Amelia North**, December 20, 1853. Their children were: **Clara Jane**; **Mary Agnes**; **Ida Bell**; **Amelia North**; and **Calvin North**; all deceased; and **Dallas Clinton**, of Dennison, Jackson County, Kan. **Mr. Thompson** was married, secondly, in New Bloomfield, Perry County, Pa., on September 11, 1860, to **Sarah E. Toomey**, who was born in Juniata Township, Perry County. She is a daughter of **Henry Toomey**, a farmer of Scotch-Irish descent, who was a native of York County, Pa. Their children are: **Ida M. (Mrs. E. E. McCauley)**, of Harrisburg, Pa.; **Rettie M. (Mrs. R. W. Grubb)**, of Perry Valley, Perry County; **Annie L.**; **Robert M.**, of Perry County; **Nora E.**, deceased; **Harry T.**, of Thompsontown; **Domer**, of Harrisburg; and **Lottie A.**, of Thompsontown. **Mr. Thompson** was a Republican, politically. He was a consistent member of the United Presbyterian Church, and was highly esteemed and respected in the community in which he lived.
