Professor John Andrew Tressler was the oldest son of **Col. John** and **Elizabeth (Loy) Tressler**, and was born at Loysville. His early education was secured in the local schools. He graduated from Pennsylvania College at Gettysburg in 1848. He then became an instructor in the State University at Columbus, Ohio, reading law simultaneously. There he met and became a close friend of Stephen A. Douglas, later a national figure. He died September 12, 1851, while connected with the university.
