Dr. J. A. Ulsh was born in Greenwood Township, December 10, 1854, the son of **George** and **Susannah (Cauffman) Ulsh**. He attended the public schools and the Freeburg Academy (1870-71), and the Juniata Normal School at Millerstown (1872-73). He taught in the public schools of Greenwood and Liverpool Townships, and graduated in 1878 at the Medical College of Ohio, now the University of Cincinnati. He took postgraduate courses at Philadelphia Polyclinic and College of Graduates in Medicine, 1885 and 1893. He practiced medicine at Enders, Dauphin County, from 1878 to 1881, and at Elizabethville, 1881 to 1885, since which time he has been practicing in Lykens.
