Henry C. Urich, 86, of Buffalo Twp., Newport, died Tuesday, June 29, 2010.

He was born Oct. 5, 1923 in Buffalo Twp. to **George** and **Mazie (Finton) Urich**. He lived in the same house his entire life.

He retired from the Pennsylvania Railroad and PennDOT; an Army veteran of World War II, serving in the 97th Infantry Division, 322nd Engineer Combat Battalion; and a 60-year member of Liverpool American Legion Post 364 and a member of Newport Social Order of Owls.
