John C. Wagner was born in Saville Township, March 10, 1872, the son of **John W.** and **Sarah (Eby) Wagner**. He attended the public schools, Millerstown High School, New Bloomfield Academy, and graduated from the Cumberland Valley State Normal School in 1892. Since that time he has done special work under various institutions. He taught in the townships of Miller and Howe, and was principal of the schools at Mt. Holly, 1892-97, and of Newport, 1897-1903. Since that time he has been superintendent of the schools of Carlisle, Pa. In 1905 Dickinson conferred the M.A. degree upon him. In 1917 he was elected treasurer of the Pennsylvania State Educational Association, in which position he still serves.
