Rev. Scott R. Wagner was born in Saville Township, August 16, 1874, the son of **John W.** and **Sarah (Eby) Wagner**. He attended the public schools, the New Bloomfield Academy, where he graduated in 1893, and Franklin and Marshall College, where he graduated in 1897. He then entered the Reformed Theological Seminary, and graduated in 1900. He served congregations in Allentown, Riegelsville, and Reading, Pa., and is now pastor of Zion Reformed Church at Hagerstown, Md. He received the degree of D.D. in 1918. He served as chaplain in the World War with the rank of first lieutenant, being stationed at Camp Zachary Taylor, in Kentucky, and Camp Jackson, in South Carolina.
