Jane E. Wallace, 90, of Spring Road, Shermans Dale, died Friday, April 10, 2009 in the Church of God Home, Carlisle.

She was born March 15, 1919 in Shermans Dale to the late **Archie** and **Mary (Crum) McAllister**.
