Sandra J. “Sandy” Wallis, 72, of Liverpool died Thursday, Oct. 18, 2012 at home.

She was the widow of **Richard W. “Turtle” Wallis Sr.**, who died July 14, 2011. Surviving are three sons, **Robert “Bob”** of Liverpool, **Timothy “Tim”** of Bloomsburg and **Richard “Rich” Jr.** of Liverpool; two sisters, **Phyllis Atkinson** and **Wanda Althouse**; two brothers, **Roy Smith** and **Jack Smith**; and nieces and nephews.

A service was held Oct. 22 in her church with the Rev. Peter H. Kuebler officiating. Burial was in the church cemetery.
