

Susan E. (Lupfer) Watts, (27 Aug 1932 – 22 Mar 1905), Newspaper Clipping, The Perry Historians

Wife of **S. T. Watts**, Esq. died of apoplexy yesterday at 1 a. m., at her home at Markelville, near which place she was born August 27, 1832. She was stricken Monday at 7.30 p.m. and rendered unconscious, in which condition she continued until her death. It was the second stroke, the first having been received last spring. She was the daughter of **Samuel** and **Susan Keyser Lupfer**, and a member of an old and well known Juniata Township family. She herself enjoyed the respect and friendship of a large circle of acquaintances. She and **Mr. Watts** were married December 25, 1859. Her husband and these children survive her: **L. W.** of Altoona, **Ida**, wife of **John A. Fleisher** of Farmington, Ill., and **Anna Bell**, wife of **W. L. Super** of Juniata Township. She leaves 14 grandchildren, one great-grandchild and one sister, **Mrs. Charles Whitekettle** of Tuscarora Township. **Jesse K.** and **Dr. Samuel P. Lupfer**, both of whom are dead, were her brothers. She was a member of the Reformed Church and her pastor, Rev. J. Thomas Fox, will conduct her funeral services Saturday at 10 a.m., in the Markelville Reformed Church. Interment will be in the Markelville Cemetery.
