

**Leah (Michael) Weaver**, (20 Jul 1818 – 21 May 1903), Perry County Democrat, Wednesday, May 27, 1903, New Bloomfield

Loysville, PA – May 25, 1903; **Leah**, widow of **Benjamin Weaver**, died of general disability at the residence of her daughter, **Mrs. Henry Kell**, on Thursday morning. Her maiden name was **Michael**. She was born in Northumberland County, July 20, 1818. Of her union with **Mr. Weaver**, seven children were born, five sons and two daughters: **Benjamin** and **Jonathan**, Nebraska; **Isaac**, Kansas; **Absalom**, Mifflin County; **Henry**, of Blain; **Mrs. W.M.D. Sheaffer**, of Kistler, and **Mrs. Henry Kell**, of this place. She was a member of the Reformed Church and a good Christian lady. Funeral services at the house today on the arrival of the P.C.R.R. Train. Rev. Shellenberger and Scott officiating. Interment at Elliottsburg beside the remains of her husband, who preceded her to the grave within six days of fifteen years.
