

William W. Weibley, (26 Apr 1921 – 16 May 2010), Perry County Times, Thursday, May 27, 2010

William W. “Bill” Weibley, 89, of Carlisle died, Sunday, May 16, 2010 at Claremont Nursing and Rehabilitation Center, Carlisle.

He was born April 26, 1921 in Loysville to **William A.** and **Nellie Murray Weibley**.

He retired from Conrail after 39 years as a conductor, and sold cars part-time for the former Arnold Motors, Carlisle; was a World War II veteran, serving in China, Burma, India (CBI) constructing railroads, and belonged to the China, Burma and India Veterans Association, 726 Railroad Operating Battalion; was a member of Pennsylvania Railroad Retirees Club, and VFW Post 477, American Legion Post 101 and Brethren in Christ Church, all of Carlisle; and enjoyed models trains and collecting them.

Surviving are his wife of 52 years, **Doris Myers Weibley** of Carlisle; two sons, **Donald Orth** and **Larry**, both of Carlisle; four daughters, **Judy E. Gutshall** of Loysville, **Linda L. Apodasa** of California, **Alice B. Hipp** of Greencastle and **Deborah Stackfield** of Carlisle; two brothers, **Scott** and **Jake**, both of Loysville; two sisters, **Helen Goodling** and **E. Jean Adams**, both of Carlisle; 13 grandchildren; and 12 great grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his first wife, **Betty Jane Foltz Weibley**; a son, **William W. Jr.**; a sister, **Betty Nipple**; and a brother, **Donald Weibley**.

Services were held May 20 in Hoffman-Roth Funeral Home and Crematory, Carlisle, with the Rev. Alan Robinson officiating. Burial, with military honors by Cumberland County Honor Guard, was in Restland Cemetery, Loysville.
