

Kate (Rice) Weimer, (Died 16 Feb 1935), Duncannon Record, Thursday, March 7, 1935

Mrs. A J. Starkey received word last week of the death of her aunt, **Mrs. Kate (Rice) Weimer**, which occurred at St. Paul, Minnesota, February 16, in a hospital in that city, from injuries sustained in a fall on an icy pavement several days previously. She was 78 years of age.

Deceased was a daughter of the late **John** and **Nancy (Kochenderfer) Rice** and was born and grew to womanhood in Loysville, where she was married to **William Weimer**. **Mr.** and **Mrs. Weimer** continued to reside in Loysville for several years, later removing to Port Royal. Following a short residence at that place, they removed to St. Paul, where **Mr. Weimer** was connected with the Pullman Palace Car Company until his death several years ago. She was a member of the Lutheran Church since childhood.

She is survived by a daughter, **Mrs. Edith Weimer Price**, of Minneapolis, Minn., and a sister, **Mrs. Nettie R. Thompson**, of Northwood, Iowa.

Funeral services were conducted on February 18, with interment at St. Paul.
