**Rev. Charles F. Weise**, son of **Henry C.** and **Delila (Cook) Weise**, was born at Milford, Juniata Township, December 2, 1867. He attended the public schools and the Bloomfield Academy. From 1883 to 1890 he was a telegraph operator in the employ of the P. R. R. During 1891-92 he was connected with the P. & R. in a similar capacity. He then entered the ministry of the Methodist Episcopal Church, and has been a member of the Central Pennsylvania Conference for twenty-five years. During 1912 he organized the First National Bank of Three Springs, Pennsylvania, of which he was president for three years. In 1919 he organized the First National Bank of Port Royal, Pennsylvania, of which he is a director. He has been pastor of the Port Royal M. E. Church since April, 1917.
