

Mary E. (Watters) Wertz, (11 Nov 1876 – 10 Mar 1942), Newspaper Clipping, The Perry Historians

Mrs. Mary E. Wertz - Wife of **Frank J. Wertz**, died suddenly this morning at 12:15 o'clock at her home, 426 North Third Street, Bellwood, death being attributed to a cerebral hemorrhage. She was a daughter of **John B.** and **Nannie Watters** and was born at Honey Grove, Juniata County, on Nov. 11, 1876. She was united in marriage with **Frank J. Wertz** on Nov. 30, 1893. He survives, with these children: **Mrs. Mary E. Lynn**, **Charles F. Wertz**, **Mrs. Ethel Mae Estep** and **Charles Lee Wertz**, all of Bellwood, and five grandchildren. **Mrs. Wertz** was a member of the Bellwood Methodist Church in which she was an active worker and also of the various organizations of the church and took much interest in community affairs.
