Rev. J. Gould Wickey, son of **W. O.** and **Jennie A. (Hartman) Wickey**, was born at Eshcol, where he attended Prof. W. A. Baker's school. His parents moved to Littlestown, Pa. He graduated from the Littlestown schools in 1907, Gettysburg College (1911), and the Theological Seminary there (1915), after which he entered Harvard and was awarded the D.D. degree in 1921. He won a year's scholarship at the University Of Oxford, England. He returned to America, in 1920 and is now professor of philosophy at Concordia College, Moorhead, Minn., of which he is dean and where he teaches religious philosophy.
